
Yet the Alliance does not stand still and we would like to take this opportunity to inform you about some of the Alliance's news of this month. Have a good read! And stay healthy and safe!

Marcel Salathé is a busy man these days. In times of COVID-19, his expertise as an epidemiologist is demanded by national and international media. We are proud to welcome him at the SDS2020, where he will hold a speech about "Al for public goods". Salathé is a professor of life science and computer science at EPFL, where he heads the Digital Epidemiology Lab. He is the Academic Director of the EPFL Extension School. He is a co-founder of multiple startups and advises companies as well as governments on digital technologies and epidemiology.

His work on online social networks, internet access networks and peer-to-peer systems has been widely cited and his papers have received numerous awards. In 2017 he received an ERC Advanced Grant to investigate "Foundations for Fair Social Computing". Welcome to the SDS2020: Krishna P. Gummadi. He is a scientific director and head of the Networked Systems research group at the Max Planck Institute for Software Systems (MPI-SWS) in Saarbrücken/Germany. Gummadi's current projects focus on understanding and building social computing systems.
