Free Basic geodata (OGD)

Swisstopo provides numerous online tools and geodata free of charge. These can be obtained directly from swisstopo or via the opendata.swiss platform. In the future, all swisstopo's standard digital products, such as digital maps, aerial photographs and landscape models, will be available free of charge as Open Government Data, and will be freely usable.
