The **Databooster** program of the Swiss Alliance for Data-Intensive Services has been selected for the Innosuisse NTN Innovation Boosters 2021-2024 (see [Innosuisse website](#))! With the Databooster we will extend our existing innovation program into an open innovation initiative. The financial support from Innosuisse will enable us to more effectively push for innovation in Switzerland.

The aim of the Databooster program is to generate Swiss innovation in the area of data-based value creation. The Databooster pushes innovation in data-based services for the manufacturing and service sector by combining new methods and technologies in Data Science with novel business and service concepts.

"Together we move faster!" The Databooster program will substantially increase the cutting edge innovation support program already in place at the The Swiss

Alliance for Data-Intensive Services (see [Data+Service website](#)). The Databooster program is an **open innovation initiative** and is aimed for both members and non members.
